EACH LUGE TRACK IS DESIGNED FOR A SEGMENT OF YOUR TARGET MARKET

A typical park would have a scenic run, a Intermediate run and a Pro Track. Tracks are designed for SAFE yet exciting operation. Riders do not require any special skill or body profile to ride the track. (There are some riding restrictions such as weight and pregnancy)

The park is a managed facility. Riders are queued at a controlled rate for safe operation.
